



GREEN POLICY

At Gordon's Restaurant & Bed & Breakfast we are committed to working in a sustainable way. We undertake/are undertaking the following actions in order to achieve this:

We comply with the requirements of environmental legislation and approved codes of practice.

We continuously seek to improve our environmental and social performance.

We recycle our tin, plastic, glass, cardboard, textiles and paper. We actively use recycled stationery, phosphate free soaps, refillable soaps and encourage "bag it and bin it". We use a blackboard for menu changes to avoid unnecessary use of paper.

We have installed measures to reduce water and energy consumption, including low energy light bulbs, solar heating, small kettles and signage. We have also installed an energy saving meter.

We raise awareness and encourage participation in sustainable business practices.

We assist customers to use products and services in an environmentally sensitive way.

We have minimised our risks associated with social and environmental issues.

Where possible we use local produce from the Northeast of Scotland. We also grow some of our own produce each year. We also display local pictures and provide information on the local environment and activities.

We have joined the Green Tourism Business Scheme as an indicator of our sustainable practices.
